

Summary of Bylaw 998-P-14 For License and Control of Animals in the Town of Unity

- No owner of a dog or cat shall permit their dog or cat to run at large.
- No owner of a dog shall permit their dog to become a nuisance by barking or howling to the annoyance or discomfort of any person. This is a 24 hour situation that includes the daytime hours.
- No owner of a cat shall permit their cat to become a nuisance by meowing or yowling to the annoyance or discomfort of any person. This is a 24 hour situation that includes the daytime hours.
- The trapping of dogs or cats at large by citizens is not permitted.
- If a dog or cat defecates on private property the owner of the dog or cat shall cause the defecation to be removed immediately.
- A designated peace officer or representative can seize any animal to be found running at large.
- No person shall harbor or keep more than 2 dogs and 2 cats over the age of four (4) months.
- Every owner of a dog shall for each calendar year, obtain a licence for the said dog from The Town Office and failure to do so shall constitute an offense under this bylaw. The tag shall be attached to a collar to be worn around the dog's neck at all times.
- An owner or occupant of private property must not allow animal feces to accumulate on the property so as to create a health hazard.
