POSITION TITLE: EQUIPMENT OPERATOR

POSITION SUMMARY:

In accordance with the organizational chart of the Town, this position is deemed permanent within the employ of the Town. Insofar as the position is included within the Collective Bargaining Agreement as negotiated with C.U.P.E. Local 2752, the position is classified as in scope. The position involves the operation of equipment and maintenance of streets, roads and water and sewer infrastructures, water treatment plant operation, manual labor, on call, weekends and overtime as required.

POSITION REPORTS TO:

Director of Public Works and Utilities

SALARY/WAGE:

In accordance with the Collective Bargaining Agreement.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To assist in the maintenance and operation of the municipal water and sewer infrastructures as such include underground lines, booster stations, wells, lagoons, sewer lift stations, and treatment plant.
- To assist in the operation and maintenance of municipal road systems and solid waste disposal sites.
- To assist in development and maintenance of landscaped areas within the municipality.
- To assume the responsibilities of Water Treatment Plant Operator on a temporary basis as may be required during periods of absence necessitated by vacation, medical or personal reasons.
- To perform or assist with other such duties as may be prescribed by the Director of Public Works and Utilities from time to time.
- To work overtime as required. (Emergency situations, job completion)
- To operate all equipment in a safe, effective and professional manner.
