- Pull fibre through conduit to pedestals
- Install/Replace pedestals and cabinets
- Perform testing and troubleshooting if required
- Direct traffic and carry out other traffic management activities as needed
- Maintain tools and equipment as per manufacturer's specifications
- Excavation by hand where necessary
- Maintain clean and safe work sites; remove debris and trash at construction sites
