Dog and Cat Bylaw Summary

- * No owner of a dog or cat shall allow that animal to run at large.
- * A license can be obtained at Unity Town Office for dogs for \$30.00 or only \$20.00 if the animal has been spayed or neutered.
- * A license can be obtained at Unity Town Office for cats without a cost to the animal's owner.
- * The owner of a cat shall not permit the cat to urinate on, or defecate on or otherwise damage, or interfere with any property other than the property of the owner of the cat.
- * No owner of a cat shall permit his cat to be or become a nuisance by meowing or yowling to the annoyance or discomfort of any person.
