General Rules

- 1. Lie may be improved on the fairway being played. Ball may be moved a club length with the clubhead, not nearer the hole
- 2. Fence on left side of No. 4 and all white stakes are out of bounds. PENALTY: stroke and distance.
- 3. Ground Under Repair if a ball comes to rest on piled material or area marked as "GUR": relief may be taken under Rule 25-1 - no penalty.
- 4. Water along No. 5 fairway is a lateral water hazard. If ball is unplayable relief may be taken under Bule 26-1a b and c - PENALTY: one stroke
- 5. If a flagged tree interferes with play relief may be taken under Rule 24-2 no penalty.
- 6. Tee shots on Number 7 that come to rest to the right of the white stakes on the right side of number 7 green are out of bounds. PENALTY: stroke and distance.

NOTE – the white out of bounds markers referred to in this general rule apply only to Tee-Shots from number 7.

Golfing Etiquette

- . Keep power carts well away from the walking paths in the front of the clubhouse, tees, greens, ground under repair, and newly planted or flagged trees. Operate power carts with caution, courtesy and respect for the course. Cart drivers and riders do so at their own risk.
- 2. Please ring the bell at number 9 Tee-Box to alert following golfers your group has cleared number 8 green and ring one of the buzzers near number 7 green to alert following golfers it is ok for them to tee off.
- 3. Repair all ball marks on greens.
- 4. Replace all divots on fairways and tees and use sand/seed filler on tee boxes.
- 5. Keep all pull carts and bags off greens and tees.
- 6. Rake all sand traps after using them.
- 7. Allow faster players to play through.
